





Life Science Programs at Georgia Schools

Georgia ranks among the top 15 states in concentration of life sciences graduates. Between 2020 and 2024, postsecondary institutions in Georgia awarded more than 150,000 life science-related degrees. (Source: IPEDS, Lightcast, 2025)

Georgia's graduates are trained in the nation's top research-intensive institutions. The Georgia Institute of Technology (Georgia Tech) and Emory University offer a joint biomedical engineering program ranked fourth in the nation (Source: 2020 *U.S. News & World Report*). The University of Georgia (UGA), Georgia State University (GSU), Clark Atlanta University (CAU), Mercer University, Augusta University, and the Morehouse School of Medicine (MSM) also offer extensive bioscience programs.

Atlanta is home to world-renowned Historically Black Colleges and Universities.

Morehouse School of Medicine is among the nation's leading educators of primary care physicians and was recently recognized as the top institution among U.S. medical schools for their social mission.

Spelman College is nationally recognized for its role in training women of color for graduate and professional studies in the sciences. Spelman's biology department is one of the highest contributors of African-American students to our nation's medical schools.

Georgia's Healthcare Infrastructure

A key component in Georgia's Life Sciences ecosystem is the presence of world-class hospitals and healthcare talent.

The presence of world-class medical and nursing schools is vital to Georgia's healthcare infrastructure. Examples include:

Emory School of Medicine: With current enrollment of over 500 medical students, over 500 health professional students and over 1,000 residents and fellows, Emory is at the heart of one of the nation's strongest health care hubs.

Medical College of Georgia (MCG): Located in Augusta, Georgia, MCG is one of the nation's largest medical schools by class size, with 260 students per class and is Georgia's only public medical school. It is also one of the first medical schools in the country.

Morehouse School of Medicine: From the genetic epidemiology of cardiovascular disease in ethnic populations to the physiology of sleep disorders, Morehouse School of Medicine (MSM) leads rigorous basic science, clinical, community health, and policy research to improve the health and well-being of people everywhere.

Lewis College of Nursing and Health Professions — Georgia State University: For more than 50 years, the Lewis College has graduated more than 6,600 nurses, nurse practitioners, educators and researchers to serve in Georgia and beyond.

WellStar School of Nursing — Kennesaw State University: WellStar School of Nursing offers bachelor's, master's and doctorate degrees in nursing. The school announced expansion of the program in February of 2020 with plans to double enrollment to 1,000 students by 2026.



Georgia is home to over **500,000** healthcare practitioners and healthcare support workers. The number of workers in healthcare fields has increased by **57%** since 2010, compared to U.S. growth of **44%**. Georgia will see another 16% growth in number of healthcare workers between 2025 and 2035.

Georgia Bio

Georgia Bio is an independent, non-profit trade association focused on growing Georgia's life sciences industry. The association works on behalf of 200 member organizations to drive public policy and build a network of industry leaders. Members include companies, universities, research institutions, government groups and other industry associations involved in discovery and application of life sciences products and related services

Georgia is home to some of the world's leading life science non-profits. Organizations like CARE and two newly-formed organizations, Center for Global Health Innovation (CGHI) and the Global Health Crisis Coordination Center (GHC3), play important roles in the international fight against COVID-19. CGHI represents more than 250 cross-functional organizations that together are developing efficient and effective responses to global health crises. CGHI's diverse membership draws from academia and the business community. GHC3, launched in Atlanta upon the request of the CDC Foundation, works with public health agencies all over the world as they respond to COVID-19 challenges.

GCMI's T3Labs provides preclinical testing and training services to medical device, biologics and pharmaceutical developers and manufacturers.

Georgia Tech's Advanced Technology Development Center coaches Georgia startups and helps connect them with resources, funding and potential customers.

University of Georgia Innovation Gateway fosters a network of industry, economic development and university partners. Since 2015 more than 20 companies have launched from the Innovation Gateway.

Emory Healthcare Innovation Hub is a premier healthcare advancement and commercialization program

Georgia Tech Enterprise Park, upon expansion completion, will include 370,000 square feet of lab space and will be the cornerstone of a new West Midtown Atlanta life sciences innovation hub.

Technology Enterprise Park, also in development, will include 610,000 square feet of lab and research space and sits on the southwest border of Georgia Tech.

Ensuring a Pipeline of Talent

HOPE Scholarship: Tuition-Free College for Georgia's Brightest Students

Since the HOPE Scholarship's inception in 1993, the State of Georgia has awarded free pre-kindergarten programs and full college tuition waivers to 1.8 million top-performing students with total awards of \$11.2 million.

HOPE Scholarship & Zell Miller Grant

Georgia high school graduates earning a 3.0 GPA or higher are eligible for the HOPE Scholarship and/or Zell Miller Grant, which covers up to 100% of tuition at in-state public post-secondary institutions.

Georgia's Tax Credits and Expedited Permitting

The Georgia Economic Renewal Act of 2021: This legislation provides a number of business tax credits including a \$1,250 job tax credit bonus for each job created by a medical equipment and supplies manufacturer or a pharmaceutical and medicine manufacturer.

Additional Credits and Exemptions include:

Energy Used in Manufacturing Sales Tax Exemption: Energy used directly or indirectly in the manufacturing process is exempt from sales and use tax.

Standard Job Tax Credit and Quality Job Tax Credit: Companies may qualify by creating net new full-time jobs. Life Science-related manufacturing, research and development and distribution are among the types of operations that may be eligible.

Research & Development Tax Credit: Life science companies performing research and development (R&D) activities in the state may be eligible for tax credits.

Certain credits may be applied to state payroll withholding liability in certain circumstances and after meeting requirements to apply the tax credits to state corporate income tax liability first. This effectively turns those credits into cash.

Expedited Permitting: Georgia's permitting process is business-friendly. The Georgia Environmental Protection Division recently introduced a new Expedited Permitting Program that is available to businesses in need of quicker permit turn-around.


Georgia's Bioscience Training Center and Quick Start

Located in Social Circle, Georgia, the Georgia Bioscience Training Center serves as Georgia's first stand-alone facility dedicated to providing customized workforce training for companies in the life sciences sector. Quick Start, Georgia's internationally renowned workforce development organization, designed and delivered training for the Center's first customer, Takada (formerly Baxalta), as they opened a new plasma

fractionation plant. The Center's flexible design accommodates training needs for companies from one end of the life sciences spectrum to the other, providing the appropriate facility needs for companies with vastly different processes. This world-class training environment paired with Quick Start expertise provide superior workforce development capabilities for life science companies growing in Georgia.
